

Scholarship Guidelines

1. Each year CECC will make available one \$500 scholarship to a qualified high school senior in each school which has at least a portion of its district served by CECC.
2. Applications for the scholarship must be made through the high school.
3. The school administration will make the selection based on the applicant's:
 - a. Financial need
 - b. Scholastic rank (to be in the top 15% of the class)
 - c. Participation in extra curricular activities (school and community)
4. Preference will be given to those applicants whose parents or legal guardians receive service from CECC.
5. The scholarship will be paid by CECC directly to the institution of higher education where the recipient is enrolled.
6. The school will provide profile information to CECC about each recipient as allowed.
