

HAR-BER PTSO SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

The Har-Ber PTSO Scholarship Fund provides financial support to a graduate of Har-Ber High School pursuing a post-secondary degree at a university or vocational school.

USE OF FUNDS

This scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, fees, room and board over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- ◆ Graduating Har-Ber seniors
- ◆ Enrolling at a university/ vocational school.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.



CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection

committee based on the information provided on the application.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$500. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the PTSO based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

RENEWABLE

This scholarship is non-renewable.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. Completed applications and required paperwork are due to the Counseling Center at Har-Ber High School by noon April 1.
2. Use the district common application, then attach a typed essay of approximately 500 words answering **one** of the following questions. **DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE PAGE.**
 - What do you consider the single most important societal problem and why?
 - Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced you and your development.
 - How has your family background affected the way you see the world?
3. The selection committee will review applications and determine recipients.
4. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
