
The MEEP Scholarship: Mother's Educational Endowment of Promise Scholarship

PURPOSE

The MEEP Scholarship provides financial support to a graduate of a Springdale District High School who is pursuing post-secondary education at public university or vocational school.

USE OF FUNDS

This scholarship helps deserving students continue their education beyond high school by providing financial assistance for tuition, books, and supplies over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must:

- ◆ Have attended **Helen Tyson Middle School** at least one year.
- ◆ Be graduating seniors entering college or vocational school the fall immediately after high school graduation.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee,

and may include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, and volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$2,000. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the donor based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available in the scholarship fund.

RENEWABLE

The scholarship is not renewable. The funds will be disbursed \$1,000 per semester upon presenting proof of class registration to the donor. The student's course load must be 12 credit hours per semester and the student must earn a minimum 2.5 grade point average to receive the remaining \$1,000.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. Completed applications and required paperwork are due to the high school counseling office by April 1.
2. The selection committee will review applications.
3. The recipient will be notified of the final scholarship decision at the senior assembly.
