

ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES OF ARKANSAS YOUTH TOUR 2019-2020 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SCHOLARSHIP/SELECTION:

One \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior each year.

ELIGIBILITY:

- The student must graduate by the end of the 2018-2019 school year.
- Student's parents or guardians are members of one of the 17 distribution cooperatives each year.
- The student must attend the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association Youth Leadership
 Council meeting in Washington, D.C. in the summer of 2018, attend the NRECA Annual Meeting the
 following spring 2019 and attend the 2018 Electric Cooperative of Arkansas' Directors Conference.

SELECTION:


• The student chosen as the Arkansas Youth Leadership Council delegate from the Youth Tour students selected by each distribution cooperative.

DISBURSEMENT:

- Each scholarship awarded shall be up to a total of \$2,000, payable in two semesters as follows:
 - The first semester check in the amount of \$1,000, will be paid to the college or vocational/technical school after the student/recipient provides Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation with registration documentation from the college or vocational/technical school.
 - The second semester check in the amount of \$1,000, will be paid to the college or vocational/technical school after the student/recipient provides Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation with a copy of the second semester registration documentation and an official school transcript indicating that the student/recipient successfully completed the previous semester with a grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

OTHER:

 The scholarship must be used by student/recipient to attend, on a full-time basis, any Arkansas accredited institute of higher learning.

Submitting a Video Application Using a Smart Phone

- 1. Record your application video.
- 2. Create a Google account.
- 3. Open the YouTube app on your smart phone.
- 4. Click the icon in the upper right corner that looks like the silhouette of a person.
- 5. Use your Google account username and password to sign into YouTube.
- 6. Click the silhouette icon in the upper right corner again.
- 7. Click my Channel.
- 8. Click Create Channel.
- 9. Go back to the home screen of the YouTube app and click the video camera icon at the top of the screen.
- 10. Click Allow Access, then click OK to allow YouTube to access your photos.
- 11. You may choose "Don't Allow" or "Ok" to allow YouTube to access your camera.
- 12. Select your application video.
- 13. Edit it, if desired, and click NEXT.
- 14. Add a title to your video using the following format.
 - a. Student Name School Name
- 15. The description may be left blank.
- 16. In the privacy section, choose Unlisted.
- 17. Click UPLOAD in the top right corner of the screen.
 - a. Wait for your video to upload.
- 18. Click on the three vertical dots to the right of the video.
- 19. Click Share, then Email
- 20. Send to youthtour@carrollecc.com
- 21. Write down the YouTube link to your video on the Youth Tour application.
